As we begin the 2026–2027 fraternal year, Chapters should note an important update to the [Achievement Award Program](#) (AAP). To better align with the academic calendar and collegiate Chapter leadership transitions, the AAP reporting timeline has been revised.

The **Albert Benjamin Prescott Scholarship Cup Report** is now due **August 31, 2026**.

Named in honor of **Dean Albert Benjamin Prescott**, Phi Delta Chi's first Chapter Advisor, the Prescott Cup recognizes excellence in scholarship, innovation, and Chapter achievement. Long regarded as one of the Fraternity's most prestigious chapter awards, it celebrates the outstanding accomplishments of collegiate Chapters while honoring Dean Prescott's lasting contributions to pharmacy education and Phi Delta Chi.

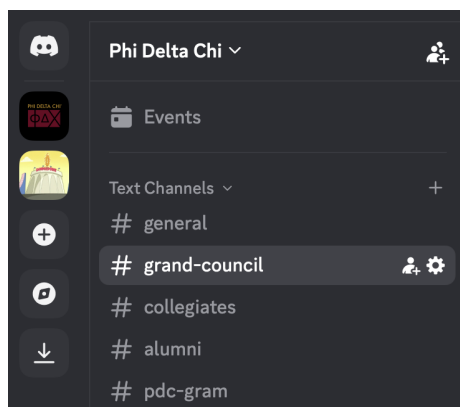
The top five Prescott Scholarship Reports are recognized annually with the following awards:

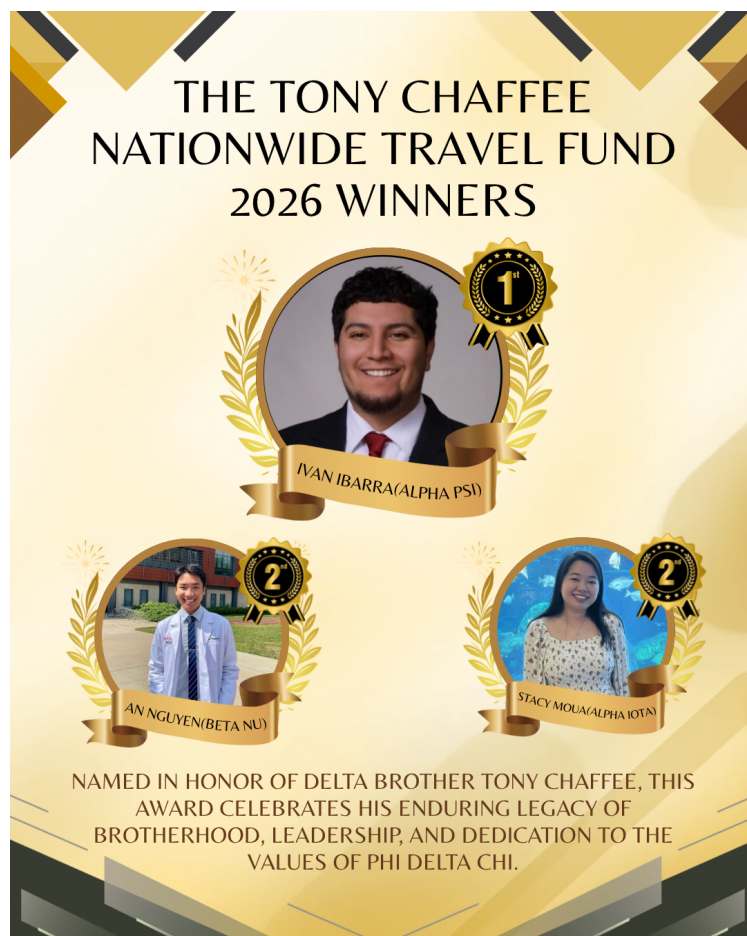

Next STAR Framework 2.0 Cohort Opening Soon

Working harder isn't always the answer. Sometimes the key to becoming a more effective leader is changing how you think, prioritize, and lead.

The **STAR Framework 2.0** is a structured leader-development program for professionals who want clearer thinking, stronger alignment, and measurable impact. Designed for working professionals, this cohort-based experience helps participants distinguish activity from meaningful results, break through limiting patterns of thinking, align their work with their values and strengths, and lead with greater purpose and effectiveness.

Unlike a one-time workshop, STAR Framework 2.0 unfolds over 4 to 5 months, giving participants the opportunity to apply what they learn, reflect on their experiences, and build lasting habits. The program combines short weekly video lessons that fit into your schedule with virtual kickoff and wrap-up sessions and engaging small group discussions that foster accountability, collaboration, and growth.

67th GRAND COUNCIL

As we look back 10 Grand Councils, we're reminded of another exciting chapter in Phi Delta Chi's history. The 67th Grand Council was held August 4–8, 2009 in Phoenix, Arizona where Alpha Nu (University of Arizona) was the host chapter.

The 67th Grand Council marked a period of growth for the Fraternity with the chartering of four new collegiate chapters: **Gamma Beta** (Pacific University), **Gamma Gamma** (University of Appalachia), **Gamma Delta** (East Tennessee State University), and **Gamma Epsilon** (Texas A&M Health Science Center–Kingsville). **Beta Sigma Alumni Chapter** also received its charter, while **Beta Nu Alumni Chapter** was recognized for receiving its charter just two weeks earlier.

Another memorable milestone was the return of the Honorary Grand President position. **Brother Ron Ward** (Alpha Upsilon) was selected by the Executive Council to serve in this revived role.

The Grand Council also welcomed a newly elected Executive Council:

The meeting concluded with **Alpha Sigma Alumni Chapter** receiving the Outstanding Alumni Chapter Award and **Omega Chapter** being honored with the Emory Thurston Grand President's Award. Looking back at the 67th Grand Council reminds us of the continued growth, leadership, and Brotherhood that have shaped Phi Delta Chi for generations.
